Giant Brick Stitch

## Area #6: Giant Brick Stitch

The top of this area will utilize the bottom lines from areas #4 and #5. The top of area #6 covers 72 threads.

Draw two side lines of 12 diagonal threads extending the diagonal lines from area #5. Refer to the area number legend if needed.

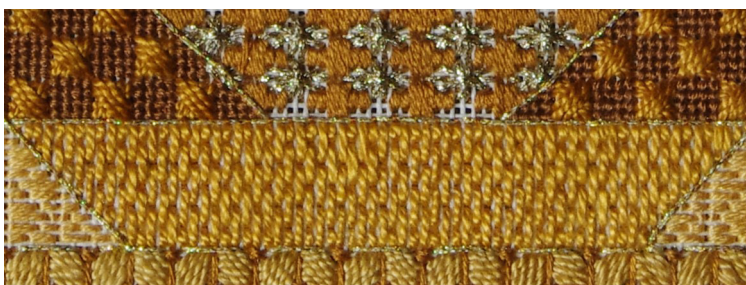
After drawing the over 12 diagonal lines, connecting the two diagonal lines for area #6 will create a base which is 48 threads wide.

Refer to the area number legend shown on page three of the introduction for placement guidance.

**Example Used:** DMC Perle Coton #5, 783

**Your Thread:**

Use the color which is one value lighter than your last thread, needle appropriate to your thread weight, laying tool (for multiple threads)



## Stitch - Giant Brick

Begin stitching this area anywhere you can execute the first complete over 4 stitch. When stitching this area, keep your canvas oriented so that the section you are stitching is at the bottom. When the complete stitches are done, go back and fill in the compensation stitches.
